- Next, please run the following commands within Linux:

wget http://repo.cloudlinux.com/cloudlinux/sources/cln/centos2cl && sh centos2cl -k **<activation_key>** && reboot

- · Please adjust the items outlined above in BOLD to their values
- After the reboot, please run the following command:

yum install liblve-devel && cd /usr/local/directadmin/custombuild && ./build update && ./build set cloudlinux yes && ./build apache && ./build suphp

Once you complete the aforementioned steps, your DirectAdmin server will be fully protected by the CloudLinux, ensuring your customers can't abuse their resources.
